Where to and Why?

- When considering where to transfer, it's important to understand the benefits of reaching your transfer destination
 - What is the **department** that you'll potentially transfer to like?
 - If you seek **faculty-student involvement**, how available are faculty for this professional relationship?
 - If you are interested in **research**, what type of research does your transfer university or department conduct and will you have opportunities to contribute?

To answer these questions, I suggest looking into the webpage of your department of interest.

Campus Resources

- For example, at Cerritos College's transfer center, transfer counselors are available on an appointment and walk-in basis.
- They can assist you with a variety of things
- For example:
 - You can create a long term education plan
 - A transfer timeline
 - Attend workshops, such as an application workshop
 - Or go on university tours
 - They also offer a whole course on navigating the transfer process

- Taking advantage of the resources at your current school is good practice for when you have transferred, because they will collectively help you move toward graduation.
