## \*What is "experience"?\*

- Fortunately, there is no concrete definition to it. Essentially anything you have been involved in can be considered experience
- Does that mean participating in my family-owned business or leading a youth program at my place of worship counts as experience? Absolutely
- The importance lies in highlighting connections between your experiences and what you are pursuing

This brings me into the value of gathering experience

## \*Why gather experience?\*

- Professionals refer to the need for acquiring relevant experience but there's a gap between gathering experience and considering it "relevant."
- Showing vs. telling
  - A list of skills and qualifications is not valid until it is shown through experience
  - Employers/university programs will inquire on how you gained your skills
  - This will be useful for resumes, CV's and while networking
- Important to know what you want to do as well as what you do not want to do
  - Learn this through experience
  - Which may help you figure out the career path that's best suited for you
- Lastly, experience is a great way to Develop skills
  - Transfer them to various jobs, internships, projects, etc.
